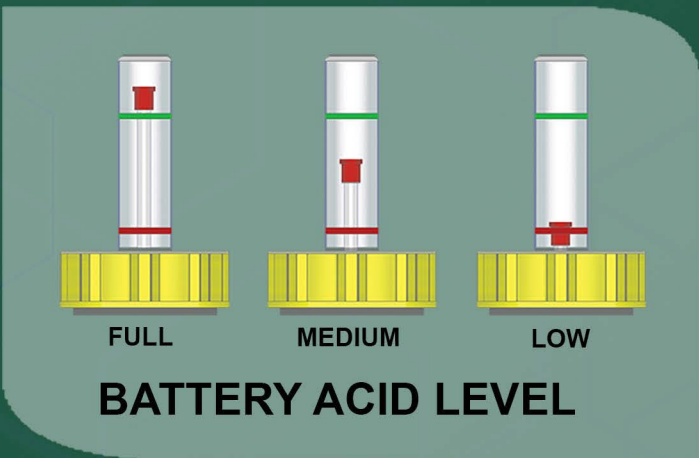

Construction and Assembly

- High Pressure Spine casting
- Monobloc container made of Polypropylene
- Dry charged negative plates
- Aqua trap vent plug
- Electrolyte contains sulphonic acid additive to prevent sulphation of plates
- Low antimony alloys and large top-of-plate-acid-head room.



Maintenance

- Low Maintenance
- Charge battery promptly after use
- Keep battery top and terminals clean and dry
- Ensure good ventilation in the room
- Recharge for 10 hours after prolonged use.
